EQUIPMENT	As per ICR Art.222.1, all equipment must conform to the FIS regulations. The competitor is responsible for the equipment he uses. Equipment will be subject to inspection in the start area.	
ENTRY FEES	<p>\$80 CAD per race, including lift ticket and taxes.</p> <p>Payment is accepted via cash and credit card. PERSONAL CHEQUES ARE NOT ACCEPTED. Each team MUST have one (1) representative allocated as payee and registrar for the entire team onsite. Registration and payment will be accepted from 14:00 to 16:00 ET on Sunday February 26, and from 15:00 to 15:30 ET on February 27, 28 and March 1, 2023, at the Race office (location TBD).</p> <p>Athletes who do not submit payment on time will be removed from the board. (Refer to Rules for FIS Alpine Continental Cup 7.1-7.5 for payment of expenses.)</p>	
ENTRY DEADLINE	<p>Entries must be received by 16 h 00 on February 17, 2023</p> <p>Withdrawals must be submitted to ACA 5 days prior to the first Team Captains Meeting. Non-respect of these instructions may lead to monetary penalties.</p>	
REGISTRATION	<p>Official FIS Entry Forms must be used.</p> <p>Non-Canadian athletes MUST be entered by their NSO through ACA: raceentries@alpinecanada.org Canadian athletes MUST be entered through their PTSO and onto ACA: raceentries@alpinecanada.org Coaches are required to pay for their whole team.</p> <p>A list of coaches, and any additional team personnel MUST be included in the athlete registration submission; please ensure coaches' contact information (cell phone number and email) is included. Any coaches NOT listed on formal entry will NOT be eligible for lift tickets.</p>
