<b>FEES</b>	85\$ CAD (65\$ USD) per race including lift ticket and taxes. <b>Bib deposit of \$100 per team</b> , club check (issued to Club de Ski Mont-Tremblant) or cash and must be given at registration. Checks will be destroyed or returned upon return of all bibs after the races. The check can be used for both races. No refund will be made to the winning team not present at the medal ceremony. (ACA rules)
<b>LIFT TICKETS AND BIBS</b>	Lift tickets for athletes and coaches will be available at registration at the Club de ski Mont Tremblant. Bibs will be available after inspection, on a bib rack at the bottom of the Flying Mile trail. Bibs must be returned on the rack, same location, after each day.
