Race office will be opened on Friday December 16th from 4pm to 6pm EST. Office is located in the Chalet Excellence Acrobatique in front of the free style stadium. Registration will be officially closed at 6:00pm EST.</p> <hr/> <p>Entry Deadline: Monday December 12th, 2022 at 19:00 EST (ICR 604.4.1)</p> <p>Accepted payment methods: cash, travelers' checks and money order drawn in Canadian funds, VISA credit card and Interac transfers to admin@clubalpinvsc.com (Question: Slalom FIS / Answer: vsc). BIB DEPOSIT FEE	\$100 per team, <u>Check only</u> . Checks will be destroyed or returned upon return of all bibs after the race. No refund will be given to teams whose medalist athlete doesn't show up at the award ceremony.

PROTESTS & APPEALS	All protests and appeals must be submitted in writing according to FIS rules to the Race Secretary office. Protest fee is \$100 CAD cash deposit (ICR 644.4).
