Eligibility:	ICR and Rules for FIS Alpine Continental Cup (section B : Nor-Am Cup)
Notes – equipment:	As per ICR Art.222.1, all equipment must conform to the FIS regulations. The competitor is responsible for the equipment he uses. Equipment will be subject to inspection in the start area.
Entry fees :	\$80 CAD (\$60 USD) per day, per racer (includes taxes and lift ticket). Acceptable payment methods: Cash, cheque to the order of Club Mont Ste Marie, email transfer of funds to Club Mont Ste Marie (payment@clubmsm.org, password : MSMNorAm), Payments with credit cards will be charged a 3% transaction fee. Personal cheques will not be accepted. (Refer to Rules for FIS Alpine Continental Cup, 7.1 – 7.5, for payment of expenses) Athletes will be removed from the board if payment is NOT received 30 min. prior to the TC meeting.
Entry Deadline :	Men, February 13, 2023; Women, February 14, 2023, (10 days before the first Team Captain's Meeting) On official FIS Entry Forms. Withdrawals must be submitted to ACA five (5) days prior to the first Team Captains' Meeting. Non-respect of these instructions may lead to monetary penalties.
Registrations :	Entry Deadline February 13 th , 2023. Official FIS entry forms must be used. Withdrawals must be submitted with confirmation to ACA 5 days prior to the first Team Captains' meeting. Entry forms must contain ALL attending coaches, technicians, etc. Non- Canadian athletes MUST be entered by their NSO through Alpine Canada C/O raceentries@alpinecanada.org Canadian athletes are to be entered through the PTSO and sent to raceentries@alpinecanada.org
